

Congressional Gold Medal for Kenneth H. Lum

Kenneth K. H. Lum became Chief Pharmacist's Mate at Pearl Harbor after graduating from the University of Southern California. He also previously attended McKinley and the UH.

Ken was the son of **Kung Sheong Doo Treasurer and Founding Member, Lum Hong Lin.**

After the war, he married Florence Wat and both of them were members of the Community Church downtown, on Queen Emma St., and on Nuuanu Ave.

Kenneth was a pharmacist at Thrifty Drugs in Los Angeles, and came back to help start the new Chun Hoon Pharmacy. From there, he started a chain of Sav-Mor Drug Stores across Honolulu, including three in Waikiki and one in Lahaina.

Kenny and Flo were the parents of Stanton, Didi (Ah Yo), Melissa Leong, Barnett, and Preston.

Ken was also the brother of WWII Veterans Charles, William, and Carl. Other siblings included Mabel Chang, Minnie Lum, Bert, Marian Chun, Melanie Jakahi, and cousin of Richard Lum.
